Introduction: Results so far in a nutshell

BIH was launched in 2019 with the mission of Bulgaria Innovation Hub to foster knowledge exchange and cross-cultural collaboration between the entrepreneurial communities in the US and Bulgaria in order to drive innovation, growth, and human development.

Since then, as our co-founder and partner at Sequoia Capital Bogomil Balkansky said: "The ecosystem has matured greatly." In the past 4 years, 52 innovative startups have completed the 8 editions of our US go-to-market programs.

Together these companies have raised over \$ 171 million and while we cannot claim all the credit for their fundraising achievements, nearly \$129 million was raised after their participation in the BIH programs. These high-growth ventures have not only successfully expanded internationally to transform industries like healthcare, EV infrastructure, space data, drone logistics, and workplace management but are creating measurable economic impact in their home country.

As of November 2023, **companies** within the BIH portfolio have collectively created over 1800 new jobs, more than doubling their total workforce compared to before joining BIH.

Additionally, a notable aspect of their success is their expansion into the US market. Many of these startups have established entities in the United States and have significantly increased their client base there, demonstrating their ability to scale and adapt to new markets. This expansion not only contributes to their growth but also showcases the potential of the region's startup ecosystem on a global stage.

The success of BIH founders is not only notable in their business achievements but also in their impact on the entrepreneurial community. As role models, they inspire the next generation of entrepreneurs back home.



Expansion to the US

- As of November 2023, 12 BIH portfolio companies have hired successfully in the US, opening at least 55 positions overseas. Others are planning to follow soon using the market knowledge and connections gained during BIH programs.
- Over \$100M was fundraised in the US.
- Portfolio companies added nearly 7000 new clients in the US, with NitroPack recording 1700% growth

Bulgaria and CEE: The Next Tech Investment Destinations

The Bulgarian startup ecosystem has experienced substantial growth, transforming from isolated successes to a robust and systematic model of success. Since our inception, the number of local ventures has increased at least tenfold, a clear indicator of the ecosystem's dynamism.

A milestone in this journey is the emergence of Payhawk as Bulgaria's first unicorn, with several other companies on the brink of achieving similar status. According to data by The Recursive, over the past five years, Bulgarian startups have collectively raised over \$1 billion, reflecting the increasing investor confidence in the region.

This growth is supported by a now thriving support infrastructure that includes over 15 local VC funds, hundreds of new angel investors, numerous accelerators, incubators, and educational initiatives. The presence of world-class research institutions like INSAIT further strengthens the ecosystem.

Additionally, the increasing media attention is a testament to the growing interest in the region's potential.

Nowadays, we can see news from Bulgaria frequently covered in editions like TechCrunch and Sifted.

Bogomil Balkansky, a notable figure in the industry, highlights that Bulgaria and other Southeast European countries are now recognized destinations for American venture capitalists. This international interest is not only a validation of the region's progress but also a catalyst for future growth, attracting more global attention and investment.

The startup landscape in Central and Eastern Europe (CEE) mirrors the impressive growth observed in Bulgaria, reflecting a broader regional trend of emerging entrepreneurial success. Over the past five years, startups from the CEE region have collectively raised at least \$10 billion, a testament to the region's promising future. This significant capital influx has facilitated the rise of category-defining companies such as UiPath, Rimac Automobili, Infobip, Viva Wallet, Blueground, Causaly, Rossum, Silent Eight, and AlMotive, among others.

The scale of investment in the region is further highlighted by the fact that over 100 companies have secured funding of at least \$10 million each. Even more notable is that at least 35 startups have raised \$50 million or more, showcasing the potential for high-scale growth and the increasing confidence of investors in the region.

BIH is growing together with the ecosystem

Expanding Mindsets and Empowering Startups

A significant aspect of BIH's impact, as reflected in our portfolio companies' feedback, is the substantial expansion of their mindsets and business horizons. Founders like Stefan Ivanov of Ampeco have noted that the BIH program not only teaches startups to think more ambitiously but also instills confidence in their ability to achieve significant milestones. The insights into fundraising, sales, marketing, operations, and legal aspects have been particularly transformative.

He says: "The biggest benefit from the program was to teach us how to think more ambitiously and gave us the confidence to see that it's possible," said Stefan Ivanov, co-founder of Ampeco. "For us, it was very useful to understand how investors are thinking and how we should be thinking about the whole fundraising process. At the same time, AMPECO was getting good traction and a good amount of customers, so we thought it was a good moment to scale. So, we were looking for advice on the best practices for doing so, and how to avoid some of the pitfalls people have fallen into in the past."


OfficeRnD: Shaping the future of work

Founded in 2015, OfficeRnD initially developed a product that empowered flexible work environments. Their innovative approach was timely, meeting the rising trend of remote work and the gig economy. Their first product, OfficeRnD Flex, provided a comprehensive management platform for coworking and flex spaces. The COVID-19 pandemic further catalyzed their innovation, leading to the development of OfficeRnD Hybrid, which supports teams and organizations in adopting hybrid work models.

As one of the first companies to participate in the BIH US go-to-market accelerator, OfficeRnD benefited significantly from the program. The support they received was instrumental in refining their pitch deck and navigating the complex fundraising process. Founder and CEO Miroslav Miroslavov, acknowledges that while the company had strong software development teams, their business acumen was initially limited.

Since its participation in the BIH program, OfficeRnD has successfully closed two funding rounds and expanded its global footprint to four locations, including a significant presence in the United States. Their **team has grown to over 150 members, and they now serve more than 2500 clients worldwide**, demonstrating both the scalability and the widespread appeal of their products.

A significant milestone in their growth trajectory came **in October 2023, when OfficeRnD received a growth equity investment from Blue Star Innovation Partners (BSIP).** BSIP is known for its specialization in scaling vertically focused software businesses, and its investment in OfficeRnD is a strong validation of the company's future potential.



Ampeco: Leading the way to a sustainable future


As a global EV charging management software leader, AMPECO enables energy companies, charge point operators, EV charging, and e-mobility providers to swiftly establish operations.

AMPECO offers a cloud-based electric vehicle charging platform that manages charging infrastructure, revenue streams, and optimal energy consumption all from one place. It empowers companies to launch and scale an EV charging business, paving the way to a cleaner future.

At the beginning of 2023, the company announced a \$13m Series A round led by BMW i Ventures as it planned an expansion to North America.

AMPECO's current standing in the market is impressive. **Trusted by over 130 customers, their software is operational across 65,000 charging points worldwide.** This extensive reach demonstrates the scalability and effectiveness of their platform in addressing the needs of a rapidly growing global EV market.

Additionally, the growth of **AMPECO's team, which has now surpassed 100 members,** reflects the company's internal growth and its commitment to fostering talent to drive its innovative solutions.



Dronamics: Pioneering the Future of Cargo Logistics

2023 marked a year of significant achievements for Dronamics, showcasing the kind of groundbreaking innovation BIH supports in its portfolio. **Dronamics, a cargo drone developer and operator licensed to operate in the EU,** has taken significant strides in reshaping global logistics, particularly with its revolutionary Black Swan aircraft.

The year began with Dronamics securing a remarkable \$40 million in pre-Series A funding, bringing its total funding to \$64.6 million. This investment, pooled from venture capital funds and angel investors across 12 countries, underscores the broad international interest and confidence in Dronamics' vision and technology.

A landmark achievement for Dronamics was the **successful first flight of the Black Swan**. This event, coming after nine years of dedicated research and development, represents a major leap forward in cargo drone technology. The Black Swan stands out for its ability to carry payloads up to 350 kg (770 lb) over distances up to 2,500 km (1,550 miles). The drone's design promises significant advantages over traditional transportation methods, including **up to 50% cost savings, 80% time reductions, and a 60% decrease in emissions**.

In November 2023, Dronamics reached another critical milestone by partnering with the UAE's Strategic Development Fund (SDF) to set up a joint venture. **This JV is tasked with the production of the Black Swan cargo drones to meet growing global demand.** The establishment of the first serial production plant for the Black Swan is a testament to the drone's market viability and Dronamics' commitment to scaling its innovative solution globally.



EnduroSat: Democratizing access to space data

EnduroSat's achievements in 2023 mark it as a standout example of the innovative spirit and growth potential within the BIH portfolio. **As a leading provider of software-flexible**NanoSatellites and space services, EnduroSat's recent developments signal a significant advancement in the accessibility and usability of space data.

A major highlight for EnduroSat was securing a \$10 million Series A funding round, led by CEECAT Capital, an EU investment firm focused on high-growth Central and Eastern European startups. The round also saw continued support from existing investors, including the German deep tech seed fund Freigeist Capital. This funding is earmarked for scaling operations, enhancing satellite technology, and expanding market share through innovative offerings like "constellation-as-a-service."

Following a record-breaking quarter in Q1 2023, EnduroSat has been consistently growing at an impressive rate of over 200% annually for the past six years. This growth trajectory is a testament to the company's innovative approach and its effectiveness in meeting market demands. Currently, EnduroSat is expanding its customer base in the US and EU, moving closer to its mission of democratizing access to space data.

Founded in 2015, EnduroSat has rapidly established itself as a significant player in the satellite industry. The company's mission is to transform how space data is accessed and utilized, focusing on simplifying interactions with data from orbiting sensors. Their "Satellite-as-a-Service" model is particularly revolutionary, addressing the typical technical and logistical barriers to space data access.

EnduroSat's fleet of over 2500 systems in space is a notable achievement, reflecting the scalability and reliability of its technology. With a team of over 130 engineering professionals, the company has successfully served more than 210 customers globally. This level of operational success underlines EnduroSat's commitment to providing robust and user-friendly space data solutions.



The next stars and future unicorns

BIH's portfolio includes a range of companies at earlier stages of development, many of which are showing exceptional promise and potential for significant impact in their respective fields.

Augment: Revolutionizing Esports Analytics

In 2023, Augment forged a notable partnership with esports giant Riot Games, known for the world's most popular games like League of Legends and Valorant. Augment's technology is now a key component in the VALORANT esports championship in the EMEA region, powering a telestrator segment that offers detailed gameplay analytics. This technology allows analysts to replay crucial rounds, highlight significant moments, and dissect strategic decisions, enhancing the overall viewing and analytical experience in esports. Such an application of technology not only underscores Augment's innovative capabilities but also its ability to integrate with major platforms in the gaming industry.

SessionStack: Leading the way in Digital Experience Analytics

Another rising star in BIH's portfolio is SessionStack, which is carving a niche in the digital experience analytics and session replay domain. Their newly developed AI tool has shown exceptional results in pilots with multinational e-commerce companies, demonstrating the potential to significantly increase revenue. The success of this AI tool in enhancing digital customer experiences places SessionStack at the forefront of market leaders in this space, indicating a promising trajectory for growth and innovation.



Phos: A Successful Exit Story

On the other side of the spectrum, BIH's portfolio includes a remarkable success story with Phos, a fintech startup specializing in software-only Point of Sale solutions (SoftPoS). Phos achieved a significant milestone as it was fully acquired by Ingenico, a global leader in payment acceptance solutions.

This acquisition is notable not just for its financial significance but also as a validation of the innovative approach and market relevance of Phos' solutions. It represents the first major exit within the BIH portfolio, illustrating the potential for other companies in the pipeline to achieve similar levels of success and recognition in the global market.

Phos has developed a SoftPoS orchestration platform combining extensive connectivity with flexible user interfaces. With a full suite of services available, including acquirer integration and certification as a service, Phos brings new connectivity options quickly, easily, and securely to its partners. The solution enables any contactless form of card payment from the main international payment schemes as well as digital wallets such as Apple Pay or Google Pay and QR code-based payments.

This deal continued Ingenico's strategic expansion into new ways of serving its clients and reinforced Ingenico's role as the ecosystem enabler of choice for the payments industry.



Our cohorts in 2023

In 2023, we welcomed 9 new companies to our portfolio: AdVentura Works, PlanDelta, True Insights, Mentessa, iCanpreneur, Releva.ai, Havelock, Structuraize and one in stealth mode soon to be announced.

While it is still early to fully assess their post-program achievements, these companies have already started to create a buzz among investors and mentors in Silicon Valley. The excitement surrounding their potential is a testament to BIH's ability to identify and nurture startups with the capability to make significant market impacts. The remark from UiPath alumni, suggesting that there might be a future unicorn among these new additions, is particularly noteworthy.

Just at the time of writing of this report, iCanpreneur closed a successful pre-seed round of €830K, totaling funding of over €1M following a €200K angel round a year ago. The Bulgarian startup is on a mission to significantly improve the odds of success of technology startup founders and product managers, by providing a guided journey, know-how, and best practices through intuitive and collaborative software.



Future plans

As Bulgaria Innovation Hub (BIH) looks to the future, our strategic vision is focused on expanding our regional reach, developing even more impactful programs, and forging strategic partnerships with more VCs and corporates to elevate the alumni experience and impact. These initiatives are aimed at solidifying BIH's position as a pivotal bridge between the Central and Eastern Europe (CEE) startup ecosystems and the US market.

The trust and endorsement we have garnered from regional companies and investors are invaluable assets. These stakeholders are relying on BIH to facilitate growth and expansion. This level of confidence is a testament to the effectiveness of our programs and the impact of our network. Going forward, we will continue to strengthen these relationships and forge new ones to accelerate growth for the CEE region.

Growth and Scalable Impact through Program Development

This mentor network is a critical part of the BIH value proposition as we provide curated introductions to investors, partners, potential customers, local talent, and mentors with relevant industry expertise to guide them through the US expansion process.

Future plans - part 2

Positioning of Bulgaria and CEE as a Hub for Innovation

To elevate Bulgaria and the CEE/SEE region's brand as a hub of technological innovation, we will focus on strategic partnerships and initiatives, particularly in the US. We aim to unite efforts and leverage BIH's position with the diaspora, local VC firms, and the CEE entrepreneurial community in the US to build stronger, more effective bridges.

These partnerships are envisioned to foster a more cohesive and collaborative ecosystem, enhancing visibility and opportunities for regional startups in the US market.

Cultivating a Thriving Alumni Network

Our commitment extends beyond program completion as we focus on nurturing a thriving alumni community network. This network would provide ongoing support through tailored development plans, fostering network engagement, and organizing community-building events. By connecting program graduates with mentors, investors, and fellow entrepreneurs, we aim to create a dynamic ecosystem that continues to thrive in 2024 and beyond.

Building a sense of community among alumni is a priority for BIH. We aim to organize and host community-building events that bring together program graduates, way more frequently than today. These events serve as platforms for knowledge sharing, collaboration, and the exchange of experiences.

Our potential to be an effective matchmaker for the #futureunicorns tribe of Bulgaria and CEE has already been evident in instances such as the connection between Evrotrust and Sim Simeonov as an advisor, Augment's success in wining the Riot Games partnership through close collaboration with BIH mentor, Desi Kilova, and the community recruitment recommendation for a US-based COO of EconicOne 2.5 years ago.
